BGI Launches Waste Management Product

Our Biokompakt® boilers are triple fuel and can burn up to 3 different fuel types, simultaneously, from over 30 pre-tested fuel sources, including agricultural and factory waste. Most importantly, they are certified to burn Class A,B & C waste woods.

The advantages of recycling waste wood are many. Firstly, free heating and hot water. Secondly, reduced waste removal costs through fuel use and drying. The Government Incentive RHI is paid per kW heat produced over 20 years. We also offer companies Technical Support to become a BSL Fuel Supplier which provides a new income stream.

How Does A Free System Work?

Strand Energy (our funding partner) will buy the biomass heating system and sell you the heat until the RHI income pays for the equipment. The RHI regulations stipulate that the payment for the RHI must be paid to the owner of the equipment therefore Strand would temporarily own the equipment.

They would supply heat to you at below the market rate for about 6 years Under an Energy Supply Contract (ESCO). After that it would be up to you when you buy back the equipment (at a fraction of the original value) and then the RHI payment will be all yours.

Harvesting the Willow at BGI

We have been busy at Hunters Oak harvesting a 1 hectare section of our 3 year old willow. We have been harvesting the whole rods and stacking in drifts around the borders of the plantation to dry.

The next stage is to chip the willow straight into our fuel store which only requires a standard chipper (no specialized equipment required as our Biokompakt® boiler can take chip up to G50 in size) thus the cost of processing the chip is greatly reduced and no specialized drying methods are needed—the sun is free!

We estimate that 1 hectare of willow will produce over 20 tonnes of chip. The cost to us is under £50 per tonne to produce, therefore we have achieved total fuel security.

Free Biomass Installations — How they Work

It is clear that the RHI offers a strong incentive to invest in biomass heating systems however funds aren't always available to invest in the equipment and reap the benefits. Our aim is to bridge that gap.

Our funding partner, Strand Energy will buy the biomass heating system and sell you the heat until the RHI income pays for the equipment.

Unlike other companies, they are not trying to find a way to secure the RHI for themselves. They will not make a profit from fuel supply or maintenance and are simply offering a fair and transparent way of using the RHI to finance the equipment that you need.

Its important to remember that Strand Energy are not a bank — the provision of the equipment will not affect your credit rating and this is not a finance arrangement. The RHI regulations stipulate that the payment for the RHI must be paid to the owner of the equipment which means that Strand will temporarily own the equipment.

Strand Energy will then supply heat to you at the local market rate for around 6 years under an Energy Supply Contract (ESCO). After that, it will be up to you when you buy the equipment (at a fraction of the original value) and then the RHI payments will be yours.
